## **Mandatory Sunday Day Camp Orientation**

For all Cloverleaf Ranch Day Camp programs, there is a mandatory Sunday orientation. Day Camp sessions begin every Monday, and Sunday orientations are the **Sunday prior to the first day of camp from 11:15am – 12:15pm.** 

## WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE SUNDAY ORIENTATION?

- Get a tour of Cloverleaf! If this is your first time with us, the Sunday orientation is a great time to take a look at the facility before spending the upcoming week here.
- Meet your counselor! Your counselor is here to make sure that you have the best week possible, and is excited to meet you and your family. With your counselor you will review:
  - Your Day Camp Packet, which will include: the schedule for the week (horseback riding is not included in this schedule), important items to bring with you each day to camp, picture day order forms, and other helpful information.
- <u>Check-in with our on-site nurse!</u> For the safest and most enjoyable week possible, we like to have every single camper check in with our nurse, who will be on the facility for the entire session. During the nurse check-in, you will go over:
  - Any special needs or allergies.
  - o Review any medications to be administered over the course of the week.
  - Lice check (Please read our Cloverleaf Ranch lice policy document for more information).
  - Brief wellness check for communicable diseases (fever, stomach upset, etc.)
- Check-in with the friendly office staff! In the office, you will:
  - Make sure all required paperwork and payments are complete and finalized prior to the start of camp.

## **WHAT IF I CAN'T MAKE IT TO ORIENTATION?**

We really recommend that you attend the Sunday orientation, as it expedites Monday morning check-in and gets you ready and excited for camp on Monday. Please do your best to attend orientation, but if for any reason you cannot attend, please arrive at 8:15 am on Monday morning to allow enough time to check-in at that time. Monday morning check-ins can be slower and more time consuming than our Sunday check-ins. It is in your best interest to come to the Sunday check-in!
